

Dear BCN Families,

This is your weekly school reopening update and since our announcement last week to suspend our reopening plans until January, we do not have additional information to report. Below is an overview of Philadelphia county data, updated on November 13, 2020. The public health metrics below are accessible on the interactive [COVID-19 Early Warning Monitoring System Dashboard](#), which is updated every Friday.

- For the week ending November 13, 2020 Philadelphia County remains in the substantial level of community transmission. This is the 4th week that Philadelphia County is in the “substantial” level.
- The county Incidence Rate per 100,000 Residents (Most Recent 7 Days) is 270.4 and the PCR Percent Positivity (Most Recent 7 Days) is 12.5%.
- As a further point of reference, the Department of Health has recommended that any county with 100 per 100,000 residents and/or a PCR was over 10% positive ratio for two consecutive weeks remain virtual.

Additionally, today the City released the following [Safer at Home](#) restrictions.

Thank you all for your continued patience as we hope to see your children soon. We will continue to plan towards our hybrid open for January and provide you with weekly updates including our adapted dates for reopening.
